VCSE Energy Efficiency Scheme	This scheme is aimed at helping voluntary, community and social enterprise organisations (VCSEs) save money on their energy bills. The scheme is now open and organisations are encouraged to apply as early as possible. If you meet the criteria you can apply for an independent energy assessment of your building's energy usage, efficiency and potential for energy savings, conducted by a qualified and experienced assessor. Your organisation may subsequently apply for a <u>Capital Grant</u> between £2,000-£150,000 to install capital energy efficiency measures. The scheme will close to Independent Energy Assessment (IEA) and capital grant applications in August 2024. Big Solar Co-op	We put solar on big rooftops (about the size of a tennis court or bigger) where the building has high electricity usage (prior to recent price hikes approx. £20K spend per year on electricity). There is no capital cost to the building owners/users and we sell the electricity generated to them at below the market rate over the next 30 years (difficult to estimate how much below due to recent price hikes). Building owners/users have the option of buying the solar panels at depreciated cost after 5 years, meaning they get all the electricity generated free of charge.	Big Solar Co-op is a national not for profit organisation with a local coordinator (Kevin Oubridge) covering Shropshire and Telford & Wrekin.	No charge for planning and installation.
